Smart board trainer certification was also achieved. Seven presentations were developed, published and given at international conferences concerned with teacher education and/or Web 2.0 applications. A successful Fulbright application was written to bring a visiting foreign scholar to MSMC to address issues of multicultural education and train the Russian colleague as a counselor for a prospective Russian chapter of Kappa Delta Pi, the International Honor Society in Education
